Corona	8.32.030 Classification of nuisances.	Yes	Allowed in single-family residential zones within permitted parking locations and in an operable condition up to 220 s.f. livable area.
Ontario	Division 6.01—District Standards and Guidelines	Yes	Allowed in single-family residential zones with certain screening and location requirements.
Riverside	Chapter 19.580 - Parking and Loading	Yes	A) For recreational vehicles < 10,000 GVWR, allowed in all single-family residential zones with certain location and maneuvering requirements. B) For recreational vehicles > 10,000 GVWR, only permitted in RR-Rural Residential, RE-Residential Estate, and RA-5 Residential Agricultural zones with certain location and maneuvering requirements.
West Covina	Sec. 26-392. - Vehicles in residential zones.	Yes	Allowed in single-family residential zones with screening and location requirements. Recreational vehicles require Administrative Use Permit.
