

BID 7933 – FY2019/20 WARD 5 STREET IMPROVEMENTS & FY2021/22 CDBG STREET IMPROVEMENTS

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BACKGROUND

- 1. The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), as part of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), provides annual funding to local community development agencies for a wide range of programs, such as infrastructure, affordable housing and economic development.
- 2. On June 8, 2021, the City Council approved the recommendation from the Community and Economic Development Department for CDBG funding for the Program Year 2021/2022.



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BACKGROUND

3. On April 19, 2022, the City Council authorized an amendment to the 2019/2020 HUD Action Plan to cancel the Ward 5 Sidewalk project on Sequoia Estrellita Street. City Council also Street and reprogrammed the \$142,314 of CDBG funds from the sidewalk project and authorized cancelled appropriation of \$51.936 additional of unprogrammed CDBG funds to a new Ward 5 street improvement project on Shelby Drive, Crystal Avenue, Snowberry Street, and Monteel Place.



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CURRENT PROJECT

- 1. The FY 21/22 locations will resurface 2.3 miles of minor streets as follows:
 - Ward 1 Admore St. from Paige Dr. to Palmrita Ave.
 - Ward 3 Siera St, Granada Ave., Holbrook Way, Canoga Pl., Ensenada Way, El Molino Ave., El Camino Pl, Del Rosa Pl., and Del Monte St.
 - Ward 4 Casa Blanca St., Evans St., and Peters St.
 - Ward 5 Myers St. from Magnolia Ave. to Primorse Dr., and Muir Ave. from Magnolia Ave. to 200' north of Ardisia St.



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CURRENT PROJECT

- 2. The FY 19/20 location will resurface 0.4 miles of minor streets in Ward 5 as follows:
 - Shelby Drive from California Avenue to the End of Street
 - Crystal Avenue from Shelby Drive to End of Street
 - Snowberry Street from Crystal Avenue to Monteel Place
 - Monteel Place from End of Street to End of Street
- 3. Reconstruct damaged concrete curbs, gutters, sidewalk, driveways, and pedestrian ramps throughout all locations.
- 4. Install signing and striping throughout as required.

Award a construction contract for Bid No. 7933 for Fiscal Year 2019/2020 Community Development Block Grant Ward 5 Street Improvements and Fiscal Year 2021/2022 Community Development Block Grant Street Improvements to Hardy & Harper, Inc. of Lake Forest, California, in the amount of \$1,950,000; and
- 2. Authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute the construction contract, including making minor and nonsubstantive changes.



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
