WHEREAS, the CalRecycle Organic Grant Program, Cycle 4 allows regional grant projects;

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WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, a regional applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2019, the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 23494 authorizing and application to CalRecycle for an Organic Grant Program and Greenhouse Gas Reduction Program.


