- February 28, 2023 City Council
 - Ordinance 7628 Replacing Chapter 5.77 in its entirety;
 - Ordinance 7629 Amending Title 9; and
 - Ordinance 7630 Amending Title 19
 - Directed Staff to:
 - Implement a Cannabis Permit Program
 - Develop a Cannabis Equity Program

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PROPOSED APPLICATION REVIEW PROCESS

- Application period 30 days
- Concurrent review of application and business proposal;
- Time to secure property 180 days;
- Review Panel comprised of staff representing City Manager, Fire, Police, and CEDD;
- No design and location review as part of scoring criteria;
- City Council not involved in selection process;
- Provide additional information regarding 5 staff positions;
- Bring process for non-retail cannabis uses at a later time;
- Provide additional information on the equity process; and
- Issue all 14 permits at this time, without equity set-aside.

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RECOMMENDATIONS

The Economic Development, Placemaking and Branding/Marketing (EDPBM) Committee recommends that the City Council:

- Adopt a Resolution to adopt the Storefront Retail Commercial Cannabis Business Permit Procedure Guidelines and Application Review Criteria; and
- 2. With at least five affirmative votes authorize an increase of five (5) (Limited Term) Full Time Equivalent (FTEs) in the General Fund for the purpose of Cannabis Permit Review Guidelines.



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RECOMMENDATIONS

Councilmember Fierro further recommends that the City Council:

- 1. Approve as part of the Resolution to adopt the Storefront Retail Commercial Cannabis Business Permit Procedure Guidelines and Application Review Criteria the following modifications not included in the motion of the EDPBM Committee:
 - a. Require proof of property control within 90 days of receiving Provisional Approval, with a discretionary extension of an additional 90 days, as part of the Preferred Location Submittal in Phase 2 rather than a condition of final approval;
 - b. Include a merit-based evaluation criteria that provides additional points to those applicants that commit to paying a Living Wage;



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RECOMMENDATIONS

- c. Include a merit-based evaluation criteria that provides additional points to those applicants that demonstrate they have previously entered into a collective bargaining agreement at another location under their ownership; and
- d. Include a merit-based evaluation criteria that provides additional points to those applicants that describe the process they will follow to ensure the collective bargaining rights of employees who have demonstrated support for a bonafide labor union, including but not limited to a card check process.

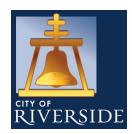


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
