SUBJECT: OSBURN PLACE – ESTABLISHMENT OF PREFERENTIAL PARKING ZONE

ISSUE:

The issue for Transportation Board consideration is establishment of a Preferential Parking Zone (PPZ) on Osburn Place from Bandini Avenue to Linwood Place.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Transportation Board recommend that the City Council approve establishment of a “No Parking Any Time, with Preferential Permit Parking for residents” Zone on both sides of Osburn Place from Bandini Avenue to Linwood Place.

BACKGROUND:

The Public Works Department received a petition from 89% of residents on Osburn Place from Bandini Avenue to Linwood Place requesting establishment of a Preferential Parking Zone (PPZ). Residents indicate that overflow parking from nearby apartment complexes is limiting on-street parking opportunities for residents and their guests.

Establishing the proposed PPZ would restrict outside parking sources and provide residents and their guests with reasonable access to on-street parking.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The cost of sign installation and issuance of permits is nominal. Funding is available in the existing Public Works Department budget.
