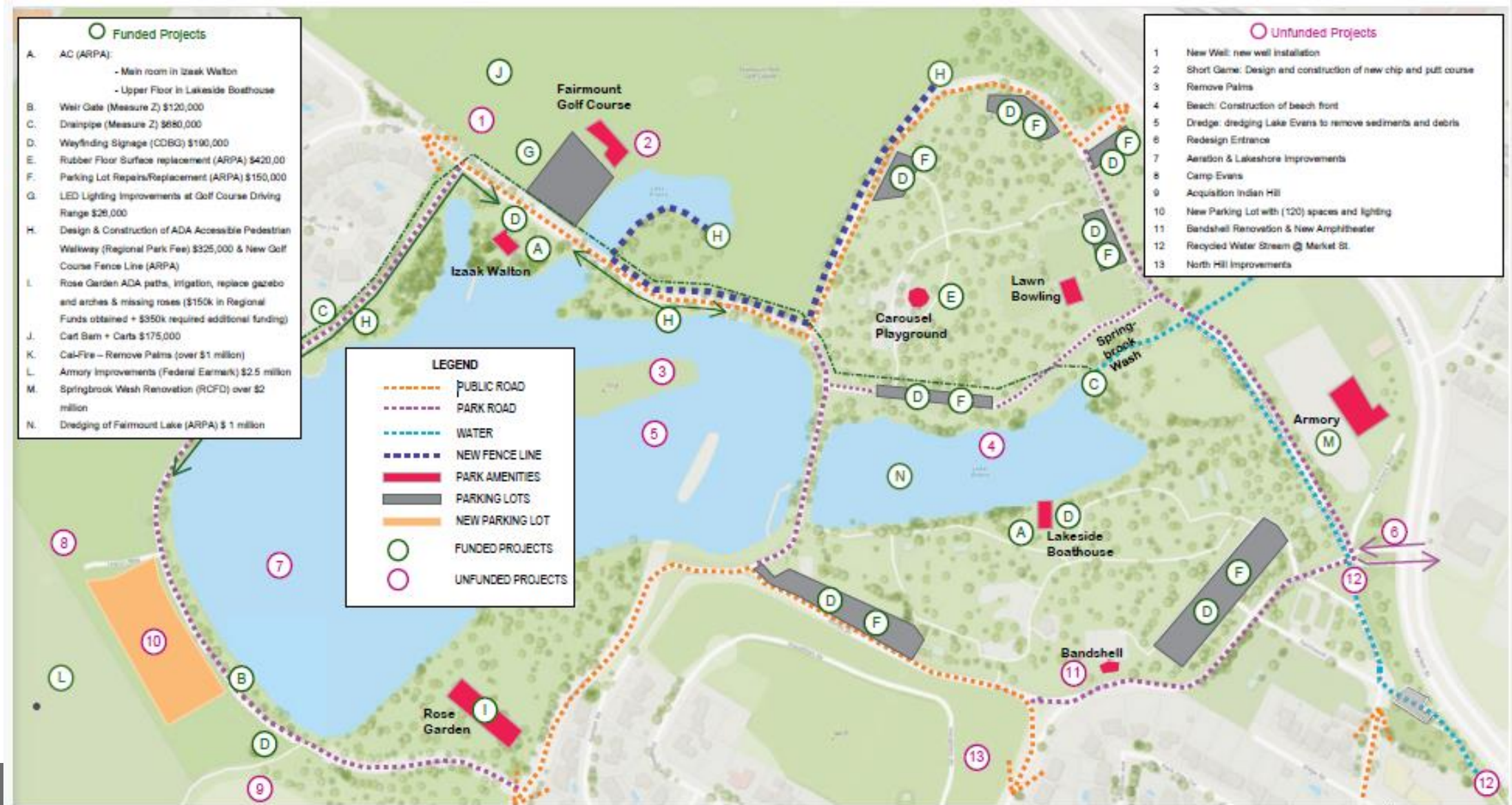

CONSIDER TASK FORCE RECOMMENDATION IN 2006



MASTER PLAN PROCESS

Activate the park while preserving the historic integrity by:

- Evaluate the existing conditions
- Consider current deferred maintenance efforts
- Evaluate historic studies and plans
- Convene a stakeholder group and community input process
- Evaluate vacant land and underutilized land within the park
- Consider potential uses and renovation of auxiliary buildings
- Articulate and recommend improved circulation
- Prepare a final master plan
- Provide cost estimates
