SUBJECT: REVIEW AND UPDATE OF THE COMMISSION ON AGING BY-LAWS

ISSUE:

review and update the Commission on Aging by-laws.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Commission on Aging reviews, updates as necessary and passes the by-laws.

BACKGROUND:

Riverside City Charter Article VIII. Appointive Boards and Commissions; Section 804 - Organization; Meetings; Subpoena Power states: "Each board or commission may prescribe its own rules and regulations which shall be consistent with the Charter..."

On March 21, 2022, the Commission on Aging adopted their by-laws which had not been revised since 2008.

DISCUSSION:

The Commission is being asked to review the by-laws, considering current trends, the 2022 by-laws, City Charter Section 800, and City Ordinance Section 2.64. Any recommended edits should ensure the by-laws remain effective for both the commissioners and the older residents of Riverside.
