
#### HOMELESSNESS IN RIVERSIDE

### CASE P12-0697 - SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION - 14601 DAUCHY AVENUE - ORDINANCE ADOPTED

The City Council adopted an ordinance amending the Zoning Map of the City of Riverside pursuant to Chapter 19.090 of the Riverside Municipal Code by rezoning .27 acre of land from R-1-1/2 - Single Family Residential Zone to RC - Residential Conservation Zone located at 14601 Dauchy Avenue; whereupon, the title having been read and further reading waived, Ordinance No. 7353 of the City of Riverside, California, Amending the Zoning Map of the City of Riverside Pursuant to Chapter 19.090 of the Riverside Municipal Code by Rezoning .27 Acres of Land from Zone R-1-1/2 to Zone RC, was presented and adopted.

### RIVERSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE AMENDMENT - TRANSACTION AND USE TAX - ORDINANCE ADOPTED

The City Council adopted an ordinance amending Chapter 3.08 of the Riverside Municipal Code to implement a Transaction and Use Tax upon passage of Measure Z; whereupon, the title having been read and further reading waived, Ordinance No. 7354 of the City of Riverside, California, Amending Chapter 3.08 of the Riverside Municipal Code, in its Entirety and Replacing it with New Chapter 3.08, was presented and adopted.
