Maintenance improvements generally include, but is not limited to, the resurfacing asphalt pavement including an asphalt rubber interlayer; the reconstruction of damaged concrete sidewalks, driveways, cross gutters, curb, gutters, bus pads, and non-compliant pedestrian ramps; adjustment of water meter boxes, water valve covers and sewer, storm drain and electrical manholes; removal and replacement of traffic striping; and installation of traffic signs.
