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BACKGROUND

1. On **October 28, 2021**, HRC members provided feedback for commissioners to submit allocation proposals for the remaining \$5,000 in HRC funding.
2. Commissioner Ayra proposed that \$3,000 of existing funding be allocated toward Community Support Grants
3. On **March 24, 2022**, Commissioners voted to create a separate Ad-Hoc Committee, to plan and implement the Community Support Grants

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DISCUSSION

1. The Ad-Hoc Committee will split the total allocation into three \$1,000 grants
2. The Ad-Hoc Committee will present all completed materials to the general Commission at an upcoming monthly meeting for final approval
3. The Human Relations Commission will partner with the City of Riverside's Neighborhood Engagement Division for guidance and support
