## Employment, Independence & Equality

### Program Eligibility

- Have a physical or mental Impairment that substantially impedes the individual's ability to secure employment.
- Require vocational rehabilitation services to prepare, retain, or regain employment consistent with the individual's unique strengths, resources, priorities, capabilities, and interests, to make an informed choice.
- Benefit from vocational rehabilitation services in an integrated employment environment.
