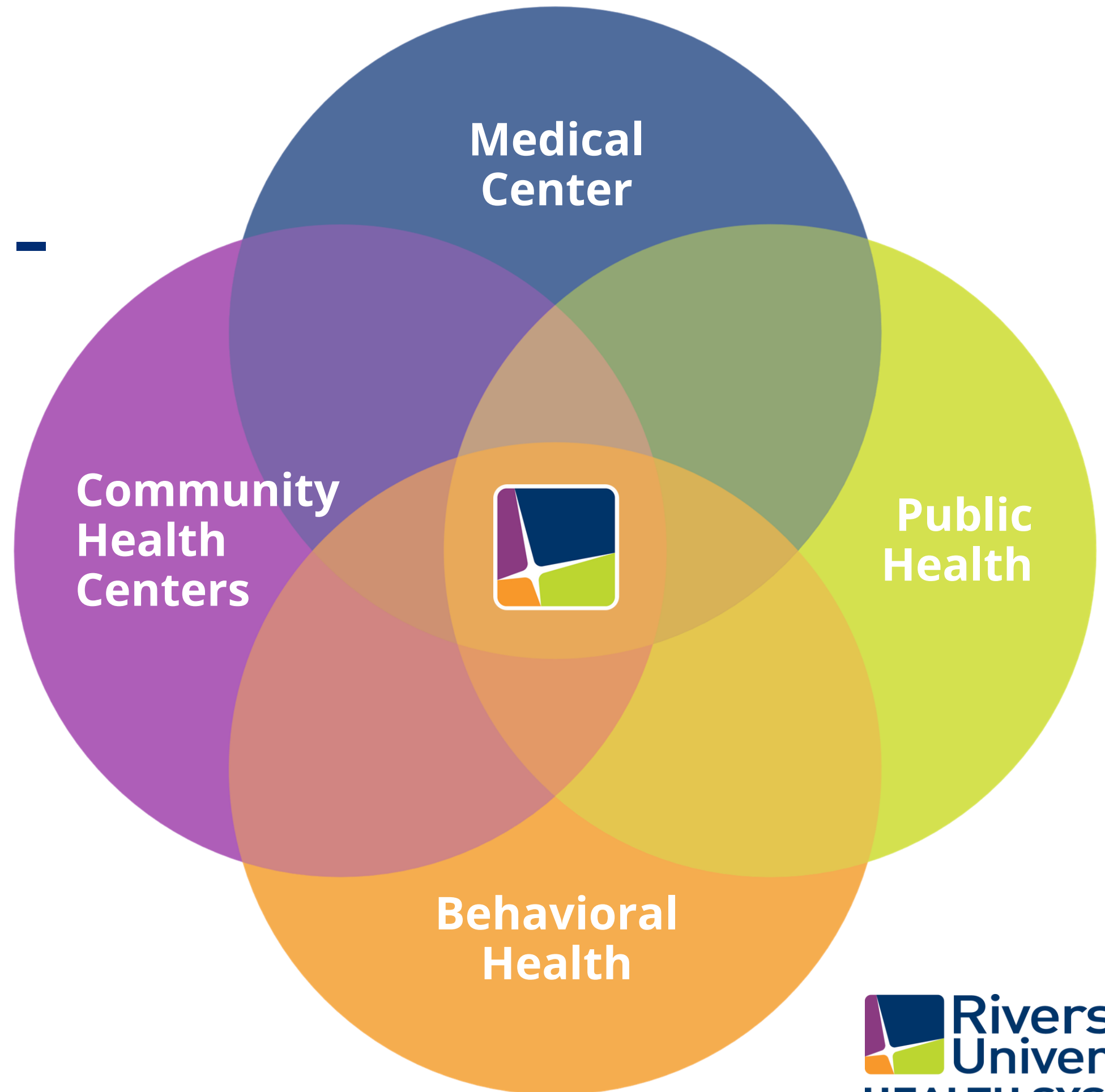

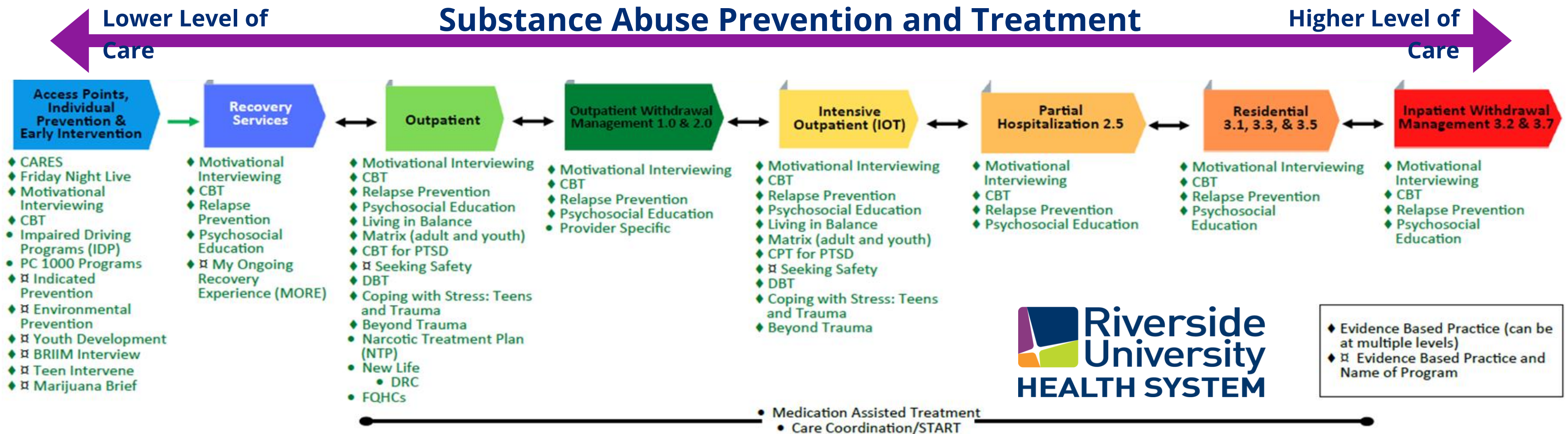

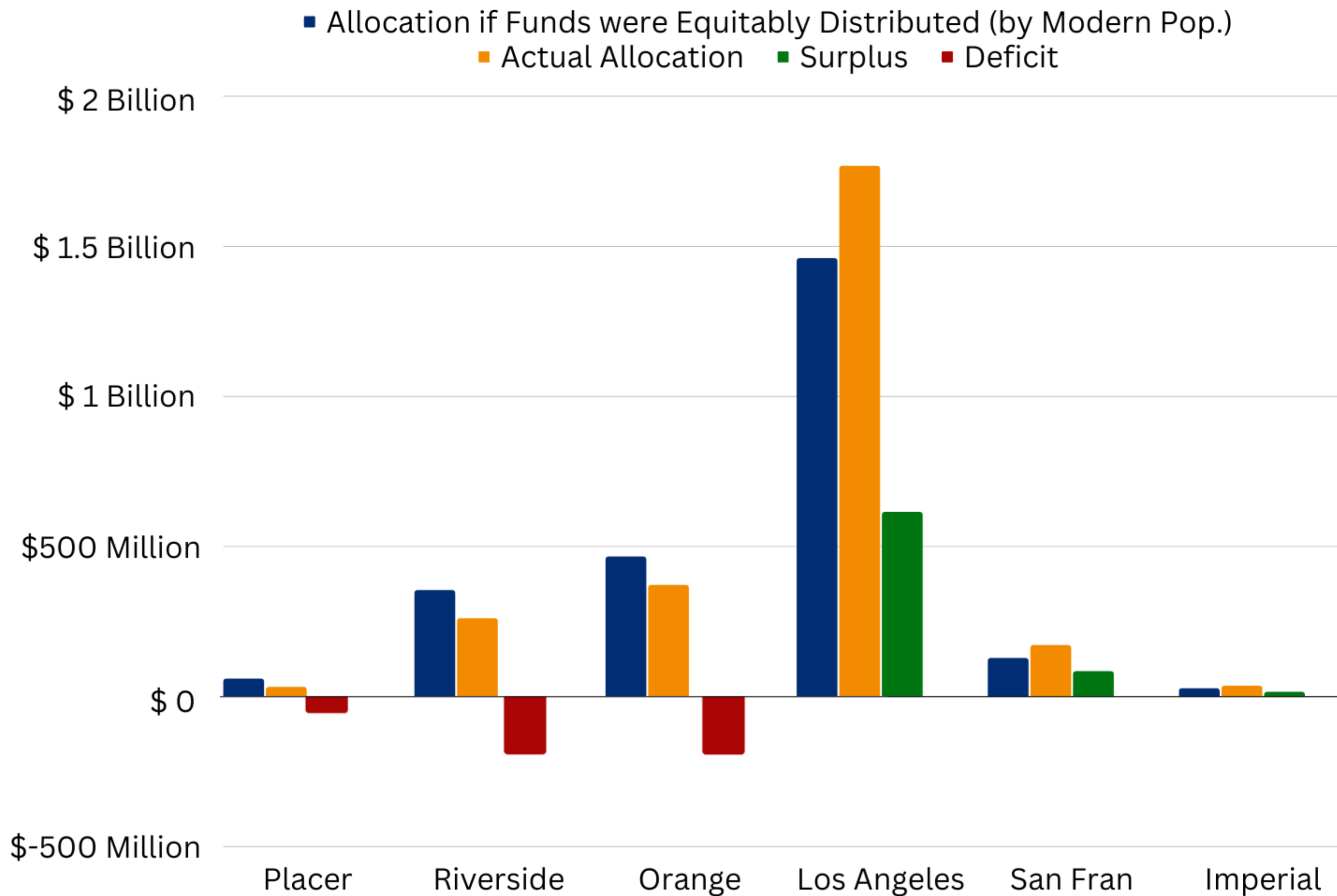

# THE PROBLEM

- 110k population more to be seen
- Rising need in the community, rapid Riverside County growth
- Aging Behavioral Health hospital needs replacement
- Not enough money
- Not enough beds (0 child inpatient), housing, placements



# ATTACKING THE PROBLEM

- **Continuum Buildout**
  - 300+ beds opened (and filled 😞) during pandemic
    - More beds incoming
  - Competitive grants
- **Crisis Teams**
  - Checking in with ERs/hospitals for ongoing needs
- **Full-Service Partnerships**
- **Behavioral Health Integration**
- **CalAIM**
- **Care Court**
- **Recovery Villages and the Future**





# Grants & Funding Awarded to Riverside County

- NPLH (\$82M)
- Recovery Village (\$80.4M)
- CSI rounds 1 (\$4M) and 2 (\$18.9M)
- Crisis Care Mobile Unit Rounds 1-3 (\$15.2M)
- CHFFA Children/Youth Grant (\$395K)
- DSH IST (\$8.1M) and IST Housing
- BHCIP Planning (\$150K)
- Mentored Internship Program (\$885K)
- Behavioral Health Justice Intervention (\$700K)
- Sierra Health Telehealth (\$590K)



# FORENSIC FSP OUTCOMES

- Decrease in arrests, psychiatric hospitalizations, crisis emergency room use.
- Increases in Substance Use identification and Substance Use services
- Jail days decreased by 48%
- Increase in Physical Health visits
