SUBJECT: BUDGET ENGAGEMENT COMMISSION, PARK AND RECREATION COMMISSION, AND COMMISSION ON AGING RESIGNATIONS

ISSUES:

Accept resignations of Robert S. Beatty from the Budget Engagement Commission Citywide Business seat, Walter H. Elliot from the Park and Recreation Commission Ward 5 seat, and Thomas J. Donahue from the Commission on Aging Citywide seat.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Mayor and City Council:

1. Accept the resignations of Robert S. Beatty from the Budget Engagement Commission Citywide Business seat, Walter H. Elliot from the Park and Recreation Commission Ward 5 seat; and Thomas J. Donahue from the Commission on Aging Citywide seat; and
2. Request the City Clerk process the vacancies.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY:

On June 13, 2019, the City Clerk's Office received a resignation from Robert S. Beatty of the Budget Engagement Commission, effective immediately. His term expires on March 1, 2020. Mr. Beatty held a Citywide Business seat on the Budget Engagement Commission. The Budget Engagement Commission includes nine business members, seven nominated by each of the Council members to represent a business located in their respective City ward or an individual who resides in the respective City ward and has a business located elsewhere in the City.

On June 17, 2019, the City Clerk's Office received a resignation from Walter H. Elliot of the Park and Recreation Commission, effective immediately. Mr. Elliot held the Ward 5 seat on the Park and Recreation Commission for a term expiring on March 1, 2023.

On June 18, 2019, the City Clerk's Office received a resignation from Thomas J. Donahue of the Commission on Aging, effective immediately. Mr. Thomas J. Donahue held a Citywide seat on the Commission on Aging for a term expiring on March 1, 2023.

Pursuant to Charter Section 802, each board and commission must have at least one representative from each of the Council Wards. The vacancies created by the resignations of Mr. Beatty, Mr. Elliot, and Mr. Donahue will be filled by registered voters in compliance with the Charter requirement.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Recruitment and appointment costs are included annually in the City Clerk's budget.
