## **RESOLUTION NO. 24180**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING AND ACCEPTING THE GRANT FUNDS FROM THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS REAP 2.0 HOUSING INFILL ON PUBLIC AND PRIVATE LANDS PILOT PROGRAM GRANT FOR THE MISSING MIDDLE PROTOTYPE HOUSING PLANS PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF ALL NECESSARY GRANT DOCUMENTS BY THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE.

WHEREAS, the Regional Early Action Planning Grant Program of 2021 ("REAP 2.0") was established by the California state legislature as part of the 2021 California Comeback Plan under AB 140 to confront the statewide housing affordability crisis by building and expanding on the success of the REAP 2019 program by integrating housing and climate goals and allowing for broader planning and implementation investments to facilitate housing supply, choice, and affordability; and

WHEREAS, REAP 2.0 funded activities must meet the program objectives, which are to accelerate infill development that facilitates housing supply, choice and affordability; affirmatively further fair housing; and reduce vehicle miles traveled. Further, all residential development must be in areas meeting the definition for "Infill" provided in the REAP 2.0 state guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the Southern California Association of Governments ("SCAG") issued a call for applications under the Projects to Accelerate Transitional Housing ("PATH") Program; and

WHEREAS, on July 10, 2023, the City applied for a grant in the amount of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) through the HIPP pilot program for the Missing Middle Protype Housing Plans for Infill Housing Site Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, in September of 2023, the City was notified that it was conditionally awarded the grant funds for the Project; and

WHEREAS, finalization of formal grant awards was significantly delayed due to proposed cuts to the REAP 2.0 program but funding was restored in the final adopted state budget and as such, formal grant award activities resumed in July 2024; and

WHEREAS, SCAG intends to award Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) to the City to complete and deliver the Project, which seeks to increase housing opportunities at strategic

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locations throughout the City by incentivizing infill development through preapproved prototype plans catered to a variety of missing middle housing types.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

Section 1: The City Council of the City of Riverside hereby agrees to, and by this Resolution does, accept the REAP 2.0 grant funds in the amount of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), awarded to the City of Riverside under the Housing Infill on Public and Private Lands (HIPP) pilot program for the preparation of the Missing Middle Protype Housing Plans for Infill Housing Site Project.

Section 2: That the City Manager, or his designee, are hereby authorized and directed to:

- 1. Execute all necessary documents for the purpose of obtaining financial assistance provided by Southern California Association of Governments, including any extensions and amendment thereof.
- 2. Take all reasonably necessary and appropriate actions to complete the Missing Middle Protype Housing Plans for Infill Housing Site Project, fulfill all obligations required, and seek reimbursement of grant funds awarded, pursuant to the above referenced call for applications and in a manner consistent and in compliance with the REAP 2.0 guidelines and objectives and PATH Program guidelines and all applicable state and federal statutes, rules, regulations, and laws.
