GOALS

Recommend pilot and long-term complete streets-oriented improvements for regulatory compliance and community safety enhancement including, but not limited to: pedestrian crossings & corridors, bicycle facilities, neighborhood traffic calming, speed limits signs, truck restrictions signs, parking signs, turn restriction signs, etc.
