SUBJECT: CHARTER REVIEW COMMITTEE INTERVIEWS AND APPOINTMENTS

ISSUE:

Interview candidates and select those for appointment to six at-large and two Alternate seats on the Charter Review Committee to be convened pursuant to Charter Section 1403.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Mayor and City Council conclude interviews and select those for appointment to six at-large and two Alternate seats on the Charter Review Committee.

LEGISLATIVE HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

On November 13, 2018, the Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee reviewed and selected interview applicants for the Charter Review Committee. Individual members of the City Council added two persons for interview.

On December 14, 2018, fourteen applicants were interviewed for positions on the Charter Review Committee. Upon conclusion of the final four interviews today, the Mayor and City Council will select those to be appointed to six at-large and two Alternate seats on the fifteen-member Charter Review Committee as directed by the City Council at their meeting of August 28, 2018. The City Council determined the remaining seats be filled by direct appointment of one each by Councilmembers and two by the Mayor.
