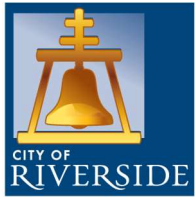
The minutes of September 24, 2025, were approved as presented.

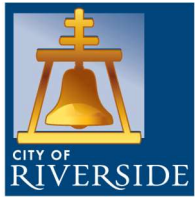
CLOSED SESSION
