

PUBLIC HEARINGS

PLANNING CASES P15-1010 (GPA), P14-0124 (AMD), and P17-0838 (ZA) – GENERAL PLAN, ZONING CODE AND ZONING MAP

AMENDMENT – CONTINUED

A Proposal to amend the City's General Plan, Zoning Code, and Zoning Map to create consistency with the March Air Reserve Base/March Inland Port Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan. The General Plan amendment includes changes to the Land Use & Urban Design, Public Safety, Noise, and Circulation & Community Mobility Elements. Amendments to the Zoning Code include the creation of Chapter 19.149 – Airport Land Use Compatibility, and the associated elimination of Chapter 19.170 – Airport Protection (AP) Overlay Zone, as well as minor amendments throughout the Zoning Code to reference these changes. The Zoning Map amendment would remove Airport Protection (AP) Overlay designations from 14 properties. Doug Darnell, Senior Planner, presented the staff report. There were no comments from the audience. Following discussion the Planning Commission recommended that the City Council: 1) Determine that Planning Cases P15-1010 (General Plan Amendment), P17-0124 (Zoning Code Text Amendment), and P17-0838 (Zoning Map Amendment) are not subject to further environmental review pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15183, because the proposed amendments only serve to implement the provisions of the March Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (March ALUCP), for which the Riverside County Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) certified a Final Environmental Impact Report (State Clearinghouse #2013071042) on November 13, 2014; and 2) Approve Planning Case Numbers: P15-1010 (General Plan Amendment), P17-0124 (Zoning Code Text Amendment), and P17-0838 (Zoning Map Amendment) based on the information and findings provided in the staff report.
