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RESOLUTION NO. 23042

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING, CALLING, PROVIDING FOR AND GIVING NOTICE OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE ON THE 8th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2016, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, A MEASURE TO INCREASE THE CITY'S TRANSACTION AND USE TAX (SALES TAX) BY ONE-CENT, AND GIVING NOTICE AND ORDERING THAT SAID SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION IS CONSOLIDATED WITH ALL OTHER ELECTIONS BEING HELD IN THE SAME TERRITORY ON THE SAME DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide for an increase to the City's tax rate of one cent, from 8 percent (8%) to 9 percent (9%); and

WHEREAS, Article XIIC of the California Constitution requires that any proposed increase in a general tax must be submitted to, and approved by, a majority of those qualified electors voting in an election to be held on the issuing of increasing the tax; and

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside will conduct an election November 8, 2016.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, as follows:

Section 1: The City Council, pursuant to its right and authority under California law, approves the following measure to be submitted to the qualified electors of the City of Riverside at a Special Municipal Election to be held on November 8, 2016:

*CITY OF RIVERSIDE PUBLIC SAFETY AND VITAL CITY SERVICES MEASURE:
To prevent cutting police, firefighters, paramedics, 911 emergency response, antigang/drug programs, homelessness reduction and youth after-school/senior/disabled services; to repair local streets/potholes/infrastructure; and to provide other general services, shall a one-cent transaction and use tax (sales tax) be implemented providing \$48,000,000 annually through 2036 unless extended by the voters, requiring independent audits with no funds to Sacramento, all funds remaining for Riverside?*

1 Section 2: That only the qualified electors of the City of Riverside are entitled to vote
2 at said election on this measure and that if a majority of the qualified electors voting on the
3 measure votes in favor of the measure, the measure shall be deemed approved.

4 Section 3: The City Clerk is directed to transmit a copy of the measure to the City
5 Attorney, wherein an impartial analysis of the measure shall be prepared pursuant to Elections
6 Code section 9280, showing the effect on the existing law and the operation of the measure. The
7 analysis shall be printed preceding the arguments for and against the measure.

8 Section 4: That in accordance with the provisions of Section 501 of the Charter of the
9 City of Riverside and the Constitution and election laws of the State of California, a Special
10 Municipal Election be held and the same is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City of
11 Riverside on November 8, 2016, for the purpose of submitting a measure to increase the City's
12 sales tax by one cent.

13 Section 5: That in accordance with Section 10403 of the Elections Code, the City
14 Council hereby requests the Riverside County Board of Supervisors to consent to consolidation
15 of the special municipal election with the Statewide election to be held on the same day.

16 Section 6: That the City Council consents to the consolidation of the Special
17 Municipal Election hereby called with all other elections being held in the same territory on
18 November 8, 2016, and said elections, where possible, shall be held in all respects as if there
19 were only one election within the City of Riverside and only one form of ballot shall be used and
20 the precincts, polling places and officers of election for said elections shall be the same as
21 provided for the Special Municipal Election.

22 Section 7: That for the purpose of holding said Special Municipal Election there shall
23 be and hereby are established consolidated voting precincts, consisting of a consolidation of the
24 regular election precincts in the City of Riverside established for the holding of state and county
25 elections as said regular election precincts exist on the date of this resolution.

26 Section 8: That the form and contents of the ballots to be used at the said election
27 shall be as provided by law.

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1 Section 9: That the polls for said election shall be opened at 7:00 a.m. of the day of
2 said election and shall remain open continuously from said time until 8:00 p.m. of the same day,
3 when the polls shall be closed, except as provided in Section 14401 of the Elections Code.

4 Section 10: That in accordance with Section 10002 of the Elections Code, the Board
5 of Supervisors of Riverside County is hereby requested to consent to the Registrar of Voters
6 rendering election services to the City of Riverside as may be requested by the City Clerk of said
7 City, the County of Riverside to be reimbursed in full for such services as are performed.


8 Section 11: That the City Clerk shall have charge of all City elections pursuant to
9 Riverside City Charter Section 703(f).

10 Section 12: That the City Clerk is hereby designated the "Elections Official" for the
11 purposes of this election pursuant to Elections Code section 320(b).


12 Section 13: That based upon the foregoing authority, the City Clerk shall have charge

14 Section 14: That the City Clerk of said City shall receive the canvass of the Special
15 Municipal Election and shall certify the results to this City Council, as required by law.
