

**BID DESCRIPTION:** Proposed project in Fairview Avenue and Cornwall Avenue will entail construction of a 12" reinforced concrete pipe storm drain line, beginning at the existing catch basin at the intersection of Howe Ave and Cornwall Ave, that will extend north on Cornwall Ave then turn west on the knuckle unto Fairview Avenue. The new storm drain line will join an existing catch basin on Fairview Ave approximately 200 feet west of Lescoe Court. Proposed project includes catch basin inlets, construction of pedestrian ramp, and cross gutter.
