



Bid 7708 – FY 2019/2020 Arterial and Minor Streets Maintenance Phase 3

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BACKGROUND

- The Public Works Department routinely receives service requests from City residents to complete various improvement projects throughout the City. This project will address some of those requests.
- Each fiscal year, the Public Works Department budgets a portion of State Gas Tax, County Measure A, and City Measure Z revenues for rehabilitation of City arterial and minor streets. This project focuses on rehabilitation of streets in very poor condition.



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CURRENT PROJECT

1. Repave 1.84 miles of major arterial/collector streets:
 - Magnolia Ave. (Jurupa Ave. to Fourteenth St.)
 - Brockton Ave. (Mission Inn Ave. to Houghton Ave.)

2. Repave 0.89 miles of residential streets:
 - Anderson Ave., Dwight Ave., Minnesota St., Patterson St., Missouri St., and Montana St.

3. Reconstruct damaged concrete curbs, gutters, sidewalks, driveways, and non-compliant pedestrian ramps per the American with Disabilities Act.



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CURRENT PROJECT

4. Install signage and striping throughout all maintenance locations.

5. Construct pervious curb and gutter on Palm Avenue near Rubidoux Avenue to improve drainage.

6. Construct missing sections of sidewalk on Maplewood Place between Brockton Avenue and Birch Street.

7. Construct a new driveway approach for an existing alley entrance on High Street between Prospect Avenue and Pleasant Street.
