- 1. New Construction with Landscaping
- 2. Exterior Reconstruction with Landscaping
- 3. Maintenance of Existing Facilities and Landscaping
- 4. Historical Cultural Preservation
- 5. Sustainable Design and Innovation
- 6. Small Business Beautification

Great American Cleanup

Over 500 volunteers participate in the Santa Ana River (SAR) and City Waterways Cleanup each year and change the appearance of the: SAR Watershed, Fairmount Park Lake, Tequesquite Canal, and Martha McLean-Anza Narrows River Trail.




















Festival of Lights

Adopt-a-Street Program


