








NEIGHBORHOOD CONSERVATION AREAS











CR SURVEY AREAS

























RECOMMENDATION


Staff recommends that the Cultural Heritage Board:

- 1. DETERMINE that the project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) review pursuant to Sections 15301 (Existing Facilities), 15302 (Replacement or Reconstruction), and 15331 (Historical Resource Restoration/Rehabilitation) as it constitutes rehabilitation and partial replacement of existing facilities to meet current standards that is consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties; and
- 2. APPROVE Planning Case DP-2024-01130 (Certificate of Appropriateness), based on the facts for findings outlined and summarized in the staff report, and subject to the recommended conditions of approval.






