

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, UPDATING THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, SEWER SYSTEM
4 MANAGEMENT PLAN.

5 WHEREAS, on May 2, 2006, the State Water Resources Control Board adopted Order No.
6 2006-0003, which created the Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer
7 Systems (“Sanitary Sewer Systems WDR”); and

8 WHEREAS, City is registered in the State Water Resources Control Board’s SSO database,
9 known as the California Integrated Water Quality System; and

10 WHEREAS, Sanitary Sewer Systems WDR requires dischargers to have a Sewer System
11 Management Plan (“SSMP”) to identify, create, and incorporate best management practices and
12 procedures to maintain a sound collection system infrastructure; and

13 WHEREAS, the City is required to review and recertify the SSMP on a reoccurring basis;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, on July 14, 2009, by Resolution 21879, the City Council of the City of
16 Riverside adopted the SSMP prepared by the Sewerage System Division of the City’s Public Works
17 Department; and

18 WHEREAS, on June 24, 2014, by Resolution 22713, the City Council of the City of
19 Riverside adopted revisions to the SSMP prepared by the Sewerage System Division of the City’s
20 Public Works Department as part of the required five-year review; and

21 WHEREAS, on October 25, 2016, by Resolution 23109, the City Council of the City of
22 Riverside adopted revisions to the SSMP as part of an internal performance audit of the wastewater
23 collection systems and asset management systems; and

24 WHEREAS, on January 7, 2020, by Resolution 23533, the City Council of the City of
25 Riverside adopted revisions to the SSMP for consistency with the Sanitary Sewer Systems WDR and
26 in the context of current collection system best management practices; and

27 WHEREAS, in December 2022, the State Water Resources Control Board adopted a revised
28 Sanitary Sewer Systems WDR (Order No. 2022-0103-DWQ), effective June 2023, requiring sewer

1 owners throughout the state to audit their existing SSMPs for consistency with the new regulation
2 and to revise them accordingly; and

3 WHEREAS, the Public Works Department subsequently audited the existing SSMP for the
4 implementation period covering May 3, 2021 to May 2, 2024 as directed by the State Water
5 Resources Control Board, and made changes to the document as part of the required review; and

6 WHEREAS, a true and correct copy of the revised SSMP is attached as Exhibit "A" attached
7 hereto and incorporated by reference.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,
9 California, as follows:

10 Section 1: That the above referenced recitals are true and correct, and are hereby accepted
11 and approved.

12 Section 2: That the revisions to the City of Riverside Sewer System Management Plan,
13 Exhibit "A" attached hereto, are hereby approved.
