- SUBJECT: CANYON CREST DRIVE REMOVAL OF TIMED NO STOPPING ZONE & REVISION OF NO STOPPING AT ALL TIMES ZONE

### ISSUES:

Consideration of: 1) removal of the existing Timed No Stopping zone on the east side of Canyon Crest Drive at the frontage of 5050 Canyon Crest Drive; and 2) revision of the boundaries of the existing No Stopping At All Timed zone on a segment of Canyon Crest Drive.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

That the Transportation Board recommend that the City Council approve:

- 1. Removal of the existing "No Stopping between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, except holidays" zone on the east side of Canyon Crest Drive at the frontage of 5050 Canyon Crest Drive; and
- 2. Revision of the boundaries of the existing "No Stopping At All Times" zone from "Both sides of Canyon Crest Drive from Martin Luther King Boulevard to Central Avenue except the frontage of 5050 Canyon Crest Drive" to "Both sides of Canyon Crest Drive from Martin Luther King Boulevard to Central Avenue except the area on the east side between Crest Park Circle (North) and Crest Park Circle (South)".

#### BACKGROUND:

The City works with residents and local businesses to establish various time restricted parking and stopping zones. Time restricted zones are utilized to control parking availability or use and stopping activity and may help to minimize safety, noise, or other concerns generated by parking or stopping during specific times of the day.

Establishment of time restricted parking or stopping zones require submission of a petition

from immediately impacted residents or businesses showing support from a minimum of 75% of tenants or owners for the proposed time restricted parking or stopping zone. Once petition criteria has been met, the proposal is scheduled for consideration by the Transportation Board who makes recommendation to the City Council regarding the matter.

# DISCUSSION:

The Public Works Department received a request from the president of The Crest Homeowners Association which serves the townhomes located at 5050 Canyon Crest Drive to consider allowing parking at the frontage of their property at all times rather than the current conditions which allow parking only between 7:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Monday through Friday and all day on weekends. A current Public Works Active Transportation Program (ATP) Cycle Il grant funded project which included installation of bike lanes on a portion of Canyon Crest Drive was underway and further evaluation allowed staff to develop an alternate design for the portion of the bike lane on the east side adjacent to the area between Crest Park Circle (North) and Crest Park Circle (South) along a portion of the frontage of 5050 Canyon Crest Drive to provide curbside parking with adjacent bike lane allowing for parking at all times within this specific area only. The small segments at the frontage of 5050 Canyon Crest Drive north of Crest Park Circle (North) and south of Crest Park Circle (South) could not accommodate curbside parking and thus require revision of the existing No Stopping At All times zone on a segment of Canyon Crest Drive to include these areas. Signage for the project has been installed and the prior "No Stopping 7am to 7pm Mon-Fri except holidays" signs at the frontage of the townhome complex as 5050 Canyon Crest Drive have been removed.

The changes implemented will better serve the needs of the townhome residents and their guests by allowing parking at all times between the property driveways while providing a dedicated adjacent bike lane to separate cyclists from parked vehicles and the travel lanes. Formal removal of the Timed No Stopping zone and revision of the existing No Stopping At All Times zone are proposed to accurately reflect the current parking conditions at the frontage of 5050 Canyon Crest Drive.

# FISCAL IMPACT:

The estimated cost of sign removal was \$102. Funding was available in the existing Public Works, General Fund, Streets Maintenance Division, Signing Supplies account number 4110100-424143, to cover this cost.
