BOOKER T. WASHINGTON/FRANK A. MILLER TABLET DEDICATION

Claudia Rodriguez, Board Member of Friends of Mt. Rubidoux introduced Glenn Wenzel, President of Friends of Mt. Rubidoux then delivered the presentation on Booker T. Washington/Frank A. Miller Tablet Dedication.

Chair Friedlander asked if there will be transportation provided for those unable to walk the mountain.

Board Member Rodriguez stated that the department will have vans available to provide rides.

Commissioner Forbes asked what efforts have been made to raise awareness about this dedication.

Board Member Rodriguez stated that awareness has been promoted through social media. Director Galera will also share it on the parks' social media platforms. Initially, a sponsorship invitation was shared on social media and presented to various groups. More recently developed is an invitation without the sponsorship component that has been developed and will be distributed soon. Additionally, the event has been featured in the Raincross Gazette as a "Save the Date" announcement.

Commissioner Forbes asked if there were plans to advertise it at the Black History parade this coming weekend.

Board Member Rodriguez stated she will contact Rose who is active in raising funds for them and has also presented it to that group who support the dedication.

Commissioner Dawson asked about the material of the marker and how it will be mounted on the stone..

Board Member Rodriguez stated the marker will be made of bronze and the installer will be cutting into the granite. A securing material will be used around the tablet to hold it in place.

Chair Friedlander asked for an electronic flyer of the event to share with other contacts.
