LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

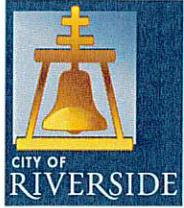
There was no Legislative update received.

PROJECT UPDATES

Public Works Deputy Director Nathan Mustafa provided project updates regarding the (1) progress of the Mission Bridge reconstruction project; and (2) Safe Streets for All (SS4A) grant agreement for \$7.5 million in funding.

Public Works Deputy Director Nathan Mustafa recognized first and second responders' efforts and contributions to the September 11, 2001, event.

Regional Director of American Pavement Systems Sam Hodson presented the City of Riverside Public Works Department with the Five-Star Decade of Excellence Contractors' Award for removing 491,409 used tires from local landfills with the implementation of Asphalt-Rubber Aggregate Membrane (ARAM) a rubberized membrane comprised of both California scrap tire rubber and tires with a high natural rubber content that provides maintenance-free street surfaces for 10 to 15 years.
