
PETITION SUBMISSION

 A petition from 100% of the 3 residences located within cul-de-sac on Irving St, north of Cherbourg Dr, was received requesting removal of a segment of the existing No Parking 8am to 4pm Mon-Fri, except Holidays zone; and

 7 additional neighborhood residents located outside of the immediate project area also signed the petition in support of the proposal.

HISTORIC INFORMATION

- The Timed No-Parking zone was enacted years ago to address overflow Arlington High School parking and this segment is no longer needed due to the following:
 - 1. Previous open campus regulations have changed to closed campus; and
 - 2. The westerly school parking lot was expanded and now provides ample on-site parking at the school.
 - 3. Residents have shared that they no longer observe overflow parking on the far northerly section of Irving



IMPACTS

- Removal of the designated segment of Timed No-Parking zone would:
 - 1. Expand on-street parking opportunities for residents and their guests;
 - 2. Better meet residents' current parking needs; and
 - 3. Have no impacts to Arlington High School operations or parking.

Note: All residences on Irving St. north of Lincoln Ave. were sent mail-out notifications of this board meeting.
