**SUBJECT: DETERMINE WHETHER COMMISSIONER ROSA JIMENEZ'S ABSENCE FROM THE COMMISSION ON AGING MEETING ON OCTOBER 17, 2022, SHOULD BE RECORDED AS AN EXCUSED OR UNEXCUSED ABSENCE**

## **ISSUE:**

Determine whether Commissioner Rosa Jimenez's absence on October 17, 2022, should be recorded as an excused or unexcused absence.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Commission on Aging determine if Commissioner Jimenez's absence from the Commission on Aging meeting on October 17, 2022, be excused or unexcused.

## **BACKGROUND:**

On July 26, 2016, City Council approved the recommendation from the Governmental Affairs Committee to amend the Board/Commission Attendance Policy. The policy states, "Board/Commission members shall make every effort to notify the Chairperson or his/her designee no later than 24 hours prior to any regular meeting of his/her intent not to attend said meeting. A member's inability to provide 24 hours advance notice shall not preclude the board/commission from exercising its discretion to excuse said absence as outlined in Section 805 of the City Charter."

## **DISCUSSION:**

Commissioner Jimenez was not present at the Commission meeting on October 17, 2022; prior notice was not given. Commissioner Jimenez did not contact designee and notified of absence.
