MUSEUM BOARD REPORT

HARADA HOUSE

Committee Member Yoshimura inquired about the status of the structure and if it held well over the past two days of rain. Curator Masengale stated that all Museum structures are checked after inclement weather and no issues were reported.

ROBINSON HOUSE PRESERVATION / CDBG

There was no update.

HARADA HOUSE FOUNDATION (HHF)

A group of HHF Associates is being formed to allow individuals interested in using their skillset but not serve on the Board or Development Committee to volunteer their efforts for HHF on an as-needed basis. Carol McDoniel offered to assist with reviewing any grant applications. No

progress on confirming if past United States Secretary of Transportation Norman Yoshio Mineta will accept invitation to serve as Honorary Chair for the Harada House Foundation. George Takei has been confirmed as an Honorary Chair. A private grant in the amount of \$15,000 has been received. The next step will be to issue an RFP or RFQ (funded by HHF) for a staged development plan for the site. The newest HHF Board member for confirmation is Judy Lee from University of California, Riverside. The Board can increase to seven members. The HHF will have an outreach table at the Riverside Museum Associates Multicultural Council Day of Inclusion event Saturday, December 8. Additional promotional items are needed. Committee Member Spiller asked if the HHF would have an end-of-year campaign for donations but at this time, nothing is planned.
