SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF THE CITY MANAGER'S APPOINTMENT OF CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER / CITY TREASURER

ISSUE:

Approve the City Manager's appointment of Adam Raymond as the City's Chief Financial Officer / Treasurer as required by Section 704 of the City's Charter.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council approve the City Manager's appointment of Adam Raymond as the City's Chief Financial Officer / City Treasurer.

DISCUSSION:

Effective August 28, 2017, the City Manager appointed Adam Raymond as the City's Chief Financial Officer / City Treasurer ("CFO / Treasurer"). Mr. Raymond previously served as acting CFO / Treasurer, and that appointment was previously approved by the City Council. Mr. Raymond's permanent appointment to the CFO / Treasurer position requires City Council's reconfirmation.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact. The Chief Financial Officer/Treasurer position is included in the Finance Department's personnel budget.
