ISSUE:

Record the excused absence of Commissioner Pendergraft from the June 16, 2025, regular meeting.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Commission on Aging records the absence of Commissioner Pendergraft from the June 16, 2025, regular meeting as excused.

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to the Board/Commission Attendance Policy Resolution No. 23976, Board Members shall make every effort to notify the administrative staff 24 hours prior to any regular meeting of his/her intent not to attend said meeting. The Board is required to express in its official minutes whether the absence of the Board Member is excused or unexcused.

Pursuant to City Charter Section 805, if a member of a Board or Commission is absent from three consecutive regular meetings unless by permission of the Board or Commission expressed in its official minutes, the City Council can declare the office vacant.

DISCUSSION:

Staff was notified on June 9, 2025, that Commissioner Pendergraft would not be able to attend the June 16, 2025, regular meeting.
