1

Ensure all Wards are represented at Community Police Review Commission meetings by establishing a commissioner attendance of 80%.

The Community Police Review Commission (CPRC) has successfully maintained an average attendance rate of 97%.

2

Achieve a 90% review rate of case files to ensure effective review of citizen complaints prior to commission meetings.

As of December 2025, the CPRC has reviewed and discussed 28 closed session cases, achieving a 100% review rate for all cases filed.

3

Achieve a 100% review rate of case files and rationale sheets submission of Officer Involved Death cases.

In 2025, the Community Police Review Commission (CPRC) reviewed two officer-involved death cases, F. Marquez and J. Tracy. The first case achieved a 100% completion rate for case file rationale sheets, while the second case is still under review.

4

Engage with the community by completing ward specific Outreach efforts quarterly and Citywide Outreach efforts no less than twice a year.

The established goal is quarterly ward-specific outreach by each Commissioner and participation in citywide outreach efforts no less than two times per year. Of the eight current Commissioners, one participated in a community event during the reporting period. No Commissioners completed ward-specific outreach activities at least twice annually as currently envisioned.

Report commission performance quarterly and ensure all commissions annually complete a Ride-A-Long.

One commissioners completed a ride-along in 2025.
