5	The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows:		
6	Section 1: Section 5.04.300 of the Riverside Municipal Code is amended as follows:		
7	5.04.300 - Business tax.		
8	Every person who engages in business within the City shall pay a business tax as set forth in		
9	this section.		
10			
11	B. Tax rates based upon number of employees or other units. Every person conducting		
12	business hereinafter listed shall pay a business tax as follows:		
13			
14	3. Contractors.		
15			
16	f. In order to obtain a business tax clearance at the time of issuance of a		
17	building permit, the applicant shall comply with section 16.04.300 of this Code.		
18	Section 2: Chapter 16.04 of the Riverside Municipal Code is amended to add section		
19	16.04.300 as follows:		
20	16.04.300 - License requirements of contractors and subcontractors.		
21	A. No person shall be issued a permit to perform work requiring a permit under		
22	this Code, unless they are:		
23	1. A licensed contractor;		
24	2. An employee, agent or authorized representative of a licensed contractor;		
25	3. A representative of an electronically subscribed service acting on behalf		
26	of a licensed contractor; or		
27	4. The property owner performing their own work;

1	D. The information required by	subsection B shall be requi	red at the time when	
2	any new contractor or subcontractor is adde	ed to the permit.		
3	E. Any work performed prior to	satisfying the requirements	of this section shall be	
4	deemed performed without the required per	mits.		
5	Section 3: The City hereby finds to	hat this ordinance is not subje	ect to review under the	
6	California Environmental Quality Act (CEQ	(A) pursuant to CEQA Guid	elines sections 15060,	
7	subdivision (c)(2) (the activity will not result in	in a direct or reasonably forese	eable indirect physical	
8	change in the environment) and 15061, subdivision (b)(3) (there is no possibility the activity in			
9	question may have a significant effect on the environment). In addition to the foregoing general			
10	exemptions, the City Council further finds that	at this ordinance is categorical	ly exempt from review	
11	under CEQA under the Class 8 Categorical Exe	emption (regulatory activity to	assure the protection of	
12	the environment), CEQA Guidelines section 15308.			
13	Section 4: The City Clerk shall ce	ertify to the adoption of this	ordinance and cause	
14	publication once in a newspaper of general circ	culation in accordance with Sec	ction 414 of the Charter	
15	of the City of Riverside. This ordinance shall	become effective on the 30th	day after the date of its	
16	adoption.
