## **BACKGROUND**

- Highway Capacity Manual establishes Level of Service (1965)
- Senate Bill (SB) 743 requires local agencies adopt Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT) as transportation metric (2013)
- City adopted VMT & modified Traffic Impact Analysis (TIA) guidelines (2020)
- 2024 VMT Mitigation Bank Pilot Program adopted.






- Transit Access, Safety, and Comfort Improvements
- Property Acquisition for Conservation Purposes
- Gap Financing for Affordable Infill Housing Development
