

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE  
4 TO RECEIVE GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE  
5 LIBRARY BUDGET ACT OF 2021 (SB 129) BUILDING FORWARD  
6 GRANT PROGRAM FOR LIFE SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS TO THE  
7 ORANGE TERRACE, ARLINGTON, AND ARLANZA BRANCH  
8 LIBRARIES, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$51,406 WITH A 50%  
9 CITY MATCH COMMITMENT OF \$25,704 FROM GENERAL  
10 SERVICES, MEASURE Z ANNUAL DEFERRED MAINTENANCE  
11 FUNDS: AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF NECESSARY  
12 GRANT DOCUMENTS BY THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE.

13 WHEREAS, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have provided funds for  
14 the program shown above; and

15 WHEREAS, the California State Library has been delegated the responsibility for the  
16 administration of this grant program, establishing necessary procedures; and

17 WHEREAS, said procedures established by the California State Library require a resolution  
18 certifying the approval by the potential grantee's governing board either before submission of said  
19 application(s) to the State or prior to execution of the grant agreement; and

20 WHEREAS, the City, if selected, will enter into an agreement with the State of California to  
21 carry out the project; and

22 WHEREAS, the City proposes to implement the Life Safety Improvements as described  
23 below:

1           WHEREAS, the City has the legal authority and is authorized to enter into a grant agreement  
2 with the State of California; and

3           WHEREAS, the City intends to apply for grant funding from the California State Library for  
4 the Life Safety Improvements to the Orange Terrace, Arlington, and Arlanza Branch Libraries.

5           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,  
6 California, as follows:

7           Section 1: That pursuant and subject to all of the terms and provisions of the California  
8 Budget Act of 2021, the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to prepare  
9 and file an application for funding with the California State Library, and take such other actions  
10 necessary or appropriate to obtain grant funding.

11           Section 2: The City Manager, or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to submit  
12 any required documents, funding requests, and reports required to obtain grant funding.

13           Section 3: That the grant award from the California State Library Building Budget Act of  
14 2021 (SB 129) Building Forward Library Infrastructure Grant Program for the Life Safety  
15 Improvements to the Arlington Library Roof Repairs, Arlanza Library Roof Repairs, and the Orange  
16 Terrace Library HVAC Repairs, as detailed in the table above, in the amount of Fifty-One Thousand  
17 Four Hundred Six Dollars (\$51,406.00) with a 50% City match commitment of Twenty-Five  
18 Thousand Seven Hundred Four Dollars (\$25,704.00) from General Services, Measure Z Annual  
19 Deferred Maintenance Funds, is hereby accepted and the City Manager of the City of Riverside, or  
20 his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into and execute the necessary documents in connection  
21 therewith, including the grant award contracts or any extensions or amendments thereof.

22           Section 4: The City certifies that the project will comply with any laws and regulations  
23 including, but not limited to, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), legal requirements  
24 for building codes, health and safety codes, the California Labor Code, disabled access laws, and,  
25 that prior to commencement of the project, all applicable permits will have been obtained.
