## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, INCREASING THE CITY MANAGER'S SETTLEMENT AUTHORITY FOR VARIOUS CLAIMS FROM \$25,000 TO \$50,000; AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 23792; WHICH AMENDMENT IS TO BE EFFECTIVE UPON ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, Section 935.4 of the Government Code specifies that a local public entity may, by ordinance or resolution, authorize an employee of the local public entity to allow, compromise, or settle a claim against the local public entity in an amount not to exceed \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 18177, adopted on February 9, 1993, and confirmed by Resolution No. 23972, adopted on October 22, 2021, the City Council set the City Manager's settlement authority to 1) compromise or settle Government Tort claims or lawsuits against the City, and to 2) compromise or settle collections, breach of contract, and subrogation cases that have been filed in court by the City, at \$25,000; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2024, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 24101, increasing the City Manager's expenditure authority from \$50,000 to \$100,000, but that expenditure authority increase did not apply to settlement of such claims against the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has not updated the amount of the City Manager's authority since 1993 and as a result, that settlement authority is outdated and not consistent with the City's current practices; and

WHEREAS, it has been proposed that the City increase the City Manager's settlement authority for such claims from \$25,000 to \$50,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: Resolution No. 23972 is hereby amended to increase the City Manager's (or his/her designee's if specifically designated in writing by the City Manager to act as his/her
