



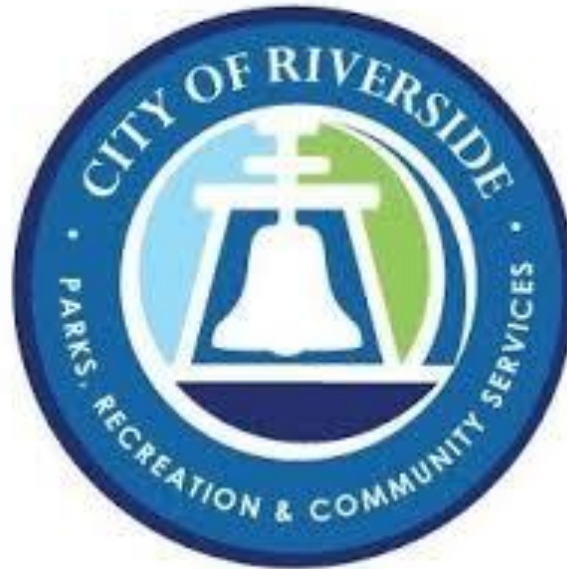

PURPOSE OF THE PLAN

“The purpose of the City of Riverside Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department (PRCSD) Senior Strategic Plan is to provide a guiding vision and identify actionable strategies to align PRCSD programming and services to meet the evolving needs of the City of Riverside’s growing senior community.”

OVERARCHING GOALS

- To engage with a variety of local senior-connected stakeholders to better understand the senior-related resources and opportunities (or lack thereof/gaps in services), and how the PRCSD can further collaborate and partner with stakeholders to improve senior services in the future.
- To engage and dialogue with a broad group of Riverside seniors to better understand their needs and wants to ensure that the programs and services that PRCSD is providing are relevant to our senior community.

EXPECTATIONS OF THE SENIOR STRATEGIC PLAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- Create an Advisory Committee to inform and guide the strategic planning process from ideation to establishing documented actionable strategies.
- Research existing senior-related data to better understand current senior demographics, trends, needs, etc. as well as the legal and policy landscape as it pertains to seniors in our city.
- Engage with corporate, non-profit, and local government stakeholders through small group dialogue and broader community forums to better understand needs and resource opportunities.
- Directly engage with local senior communities to ensure inclusion and broad representation via focus groups and the design and delivery of a survey to better understand the priorities of Riverside seniors.
- Analyze the results of community engagement survey to create actionable strategies for the PRCSD that will be compiled in a Senior Strategic Plan document.
- Implementation of Strategies in Collaboration with PRCSD.



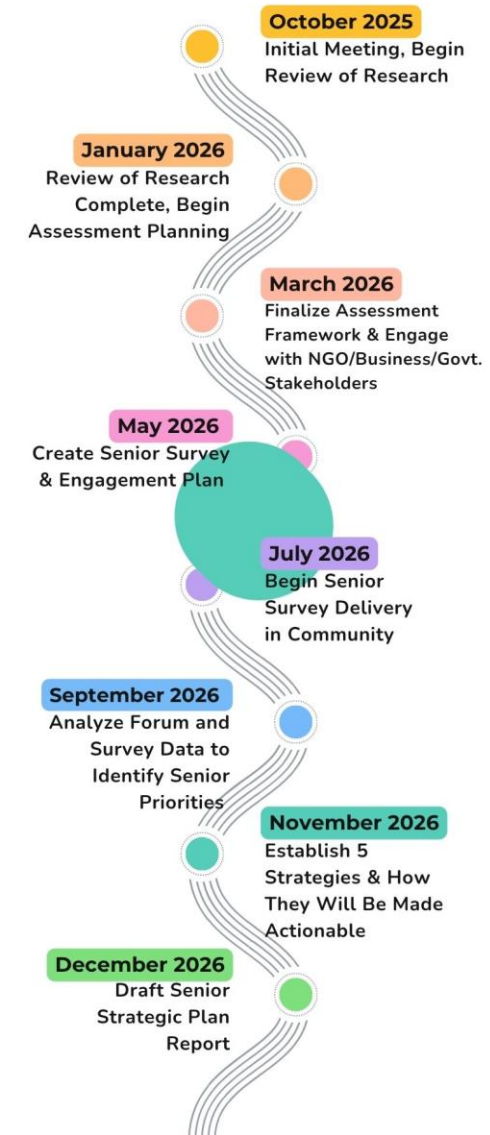
SENIOR STRATEGIC PLAN COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES

- Timeline: 12-18 month Process
 - “5 Strategies” identified by December 2026 to inform PRCSD Budget Decision-Making
