Please provide a brief description of your project and how it has enhanced your neighborhood:

The Multicultural Council (MCC) of Riverside partnered with Ramona High School for the 13th Annual Day of Inclusion. Representing Ramona, Erin Maroufkhani, Magnet Coordinator at Ramona High School organized students to develop and participate in the October 15, 2024 celebration of “Day of Inclusion”.

In observance of inclusivity and diversity, students celebrated with visual and performing arts. Volunteers assisted students and attendees in writing poetry about their personal understanding and value of inclusion and diversity. And from scraps of colorful fabric, they designed beautifully creative pieces to be used in the development of a community quilt that will be displayed in its entirety at the Center for Social Justice and Civil Liberties in March of 2025. After a Native American Blessing Ceremony, students and teachers unveiled four sections of a Chicano Studies Mural that celebrates the shared past, present and future of our shared historical narrative in Riverside, California.

On October 24, 2024, MCC presented to the Human Relations Commission a summary of the Day of Inclusion event and how the grant funds were used in the development of the event held at Ramona High School. MCC is committed to the need to focus on the youth of Riverside in carrying out its mission and vision of increasing awareness and providing education in regards to cultural diversity and inclusion. They are the future leaders.

On Tuesday, December 17, 2024, the MCC members along with partnering faculty at Ramona High School will honor the Day of Inclusion by receiving a Proclamation from the City Council of Riverside commemorating December 17, 2024 the Day of Inclusion. Riverside is the only U.S. city to have celebrated this important day for 13 years. We would like to thank the Human Relations Commission for their commitment to inclusivity.
