8	15060(c)(3) and/or 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title
9	14, Chapter 3, in that it will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change
10	in the environment nor have a significant impact on the environment.
11	Section 3: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause
12	publication once in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with Section 414 of the Charter
13	of the City of Riverside. This ordinance shall become effective on the 30th day after the date of its
14	adoption.
