Following discussion and without formal motion, the Committee received and ordered filed the update on Successor Agency-owned properties.

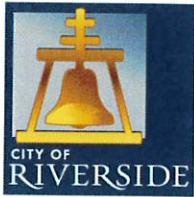
HOMELESSNESS ACTION PLAN UPDATE
