THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT ("Second Amendment") is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 20____, by and between the CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a California charter city and municipal corporation ("City"), and HDR ENGINEERING, INC., a Nebraska corporation authorized to do business in California ("Consultant"), with respect to the following:

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City and Consultant entered into that certain Professional Consultant Services Agreement dated December 21, 2018 ("Agreement") for Third Street Grade Separation at BNSF Railroad ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City and Consultant entered into the First Amendment to Professional Services Agreement dated July 15, 2020 to add additional services to the Scope of Work; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the agreement to extend the term of the agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, incorporating the recitals set out above, the parties hereto mutually agree to the following amendment to the Agreement.

1. Section 1, Scope of Services, is hereby amended as described in Exhibit "A-2" attached hereto and incorporated herein.
2. Section 4, Term, is hereby amended to extend the term of the Agreement to June 31, 2021.
3. Section 5, Compensation/Payment, is hereby amended to increase the compensation by Nineteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$19,500.00) for the additional Services.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement and the First Amendment between the parties, which are not inconsistent with the terms of this Second Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect as if fully set forth herein.

Additional rounds of review with Caltrans are expected on the cultural resources studies package.
No more than six built environment resources will require updating or newly recording on DPR 523 Forms	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A total of 29 built environment resources required updated or newly recorded DPR 523 Forms based on the Area of Potential Effects and Caltrans review comments.
Scope does not include a Finding of Effect (FOE) document	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Caltrans requested the preparation of a Finding of Effect document based on the multiple potentially historic properties within the project area in October 2020.• The FOE document was prepared using budget from other environmental tasks.
