

BID 7542 – 2017/2018 ARTERIAL AND MINOR STREETS MAINTENANCE, PHASE 2

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BACKGROUND

1. On October 18, 2011, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 22288 authorizing the submittal of an application to CalRecycle for a rubberized grant;
2. On December 6, 2016, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 23120 amending Resolution No. 22288 to extend the expiration date to June 30, 2021;



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BACKGROUND (CONT.)

3. On February 13, 2018, the City and CalRecycle entered into a \$350,000 Grant Agreement and the Notice to Proceed was received on February 14, 2018;
4. On June 12, 2018, the City Council authorized the transfer of \$1,703,734.29 in remaining 2007 Un-programmed Redevelopment Agency Bond Funds and approved the project locations for street maintenance improvements.



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CURRENT PROJECT


1. Repave Columbia Ave. from Main Street to 215 Freeway Overpass along with Primer Street and Interchange Street (0.92 miles);
2. Repave 10.6 miles of Minor Streets;
3. Slurry seal 52.7 miles of Minor Streets;
4. Construct new sidewalk on Jo Jo Way from Crest Avenue to Penny Drive;
5. Pave the alleys from Comer Avenue to Franklin Avenue between 5th Street and 6th Street;
6. Reconstruct damaged concrete curbs, gutters, sidewalks, driveways, and pedestrian ramps; and
7. Install signing and striping.

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COMPETITIVE BIDS

1. August 1st, 2018 – Four bids were received for construction
2. Lowest responsive bid was from All American Asphalt of Corona, CA
3. Bid amount: \$7,489,107 (5.12% above estimate)

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RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Award a construction contract for Bid No. 7542 for 2017/2018 Arterial and Minor Streets Maintenance, Phase 2 to All American Asphalt, of Corona, CA, in the amount of \$7,489,107;
2. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the construction contract with All American Asphalt, including making minor non-substantial changes; and
3. Authorize a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$350,000 in CalRecycle rubberized pavement grant.



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
