 - A. City Council approved grant funding for IESBDC
 - B. Local access to business support services
- 3. Scope of services has changed reflect evolving needs of business community
- 4. On August 18, 2020
 - A. City Council approved a 2-year contract
 - B. \$50,000 annually for duration of contract (total \$100,000)
