STATE TRASH AMENDMENT COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENT TO INSTALL, OPERATE, AND MAINTAIN FULL CAPTURE SYSTEMS FOR ALL STORM DRAINS WITHIN PRIORITY LAND USE AREAS

Following discussion, motion was made by Vice Chair Soubirous and seconded by Chair Mac Arthur recommending that the City Council approve Track 2 in which the City must develop and submit an implementation plan to the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board by November 30, 2018, using any method or combination of methods equivalent to the full capture system approach. Motion carried unanimously.

NOISY ANIMAL DEFINITION AND COMPLAINT PROCESS
