RE: Disposal Fee Increase - FY 2025/26

The Riverside County Department of Waste Resources (Department) is responsible for assuring that there is, and will be in the future, sufficient and accessible landfill space to properly serve the population of the County in its disposal needs. To fulfill this mandate, the Department continually maintains and expands County landfill sites, and encourages, supports, and develops recycling programs that minimize the dependence on landfill disposal facilities.

Due to sustained increases in labor expenses, capital improvement costs, regulatory compliance costs, and closed site maintenance, an increase in disposal rates is essential to allow for continued and improved services. This letter serves as a notice that subject to approval by the Riverside County Board of Supervisors, landfill disposal rates will increase in FY 25/26 by the Consumer Price Index (CPI), which is 2.88% for calendar year 2024. The FY 25/26 rate for the Robert A Nelson Transfer Station/Materials Recovery Facility will be \$43.77 per ton. The new rate will become effective for tonnage deliveries starting on July 1, 2025.
