

## KEY FACTORS

1. Public safety shall be the number one priority when considering re-opening Mt. Rubidoux Park and Trails.
2. All State mandates must be adhered to by patrons including social distancing, face mask recommendations, etc.
3. Signage to be placed throughout the trails system informing the public of criteria/conditions for use.
4. If criteria is not followed, it is recommended that the park be closed once again in the interest of public safety.
5. Parking lots at Ryan Bonaminio Park must be opened to accommodate parking needs.
6. It will take a minimum of 72 hours to prepare the site for re-opening once approval is granted.

## OPTION A



1. Split two-way lanes from Glenwood Drive entrance and 9<sup>th</sup> Street entrance to the "cross-road".
2. **One way circulation from "cross-road" with an "up road" and a "down road".**
3. Strollers and pets will be discouraged.
4. Social Distancing signage with guidelines to help keep the trails open.
5. Signage to minimize unnecessary gatherings.



## OPTION B



1. Split two-way lanes from Glenwood Drive entrance and 9<sup>th</sup> Street entrance to the "cross-road".
2. **Two-way circulation from trailheads to the top of Mt. Rubidoux.**
3. Strollers and pets will be discouraged.
4. Social Distancing Signage with guidelines to help keep the trails open.
5. Signage to Minimize unnecessary gatherings.

Stay to the **RIGHT OF THE DOTTED DIVIDING LINE** at all times until you arrive at the Cross Over.

Please obey signs and assist us in keeping the flow of participants moving in one direction.

- Wear appropriate face coverings.
- Keep 6 feet physical distancing at all times.
- Slower traffic stay to the right.
- Faster traffic pass on the left.
- If possible leave strollers and pets at home during this time to minimize slowing of pedestrians, blocking of trails and therefore causing reduction of physical distancing.

By following these requests, it will enable us to keep Mount Rubidoux open for day to day recreational use.
