SUBJECT: MEASURE Z – APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF 20 PANASONIC CF-33 TOUGHBOOKS AND ACCESSORIES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,498 FROM STOMMEL, INC. IN ACCORDANCE WITH PURCHASING RESOLUTION NO. 23256, SECTION 602(G)

ISSUE:

Approve the purchase of 20 Panasonic CF-33 Toughbooks and accessories, in the amount of \$100,498, from Stommel, Inc. of Anaheim, California in accordance with Purchasing Resolution No. 23256, Section 602(g).

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council approve the purchase of 20 Panasonic CF-33 Toughbooks and accessories, in the amount of \$100,498, from Stommel, Inc. of Anaheim, California in accordance with Purchasing Resolution No. 23256, Section 602(g).

BACKGROUND:

On April 17, 2018, the City Council awarded Bid No. 7550 for the purchase of 25 Panasonic CF-33 Toughbooks and accessories to Stommel, Inc. of Anaheim, California.

The Riverside Police Department is in the process of purchasing 20 current model Ford Police Interceptor SUV Pursuit Vehicles as approved in the Measure Z Spending Plan, Vehicle Replacement and Maintenance Plan. In addition to the standard emergency equipment for the 20 police vehicles, these vehicles will need to be equipped with Panasonic CF-33 Toughbooks.

DISCUSSION:

RPD would like to purchase 20 additional Panasonic CF-33 Toughbooks and accessories from Stommel, Inc. in accordance with Purchasing Resolution No. 23256, Section 602(g), which allows for exceptions to the competitive procurement process when “Goods can be Procured from a Bidder who offers the same or better price, terms and conditions as the Bidder previously offered as the Lowest Responsive Bidder under Competitive Procurement provided that, in the opinion of the Manager, it is in the best interests of the City to do so.”

Stommel, Inc. has agreed to provide the additional Panasonic CF-33 Toughbooks and accessories at the same amount offered in Bid No. 7550. The cost per each Toughbook is \$5,024.90.

The Purchasing Manager concurs with the recommendation and that the recommended action is in compliance with Purchasing Resolution No. 23256, Section 602(g).

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total fiscal impact of the action is \$100,498. Sufficient funds are available in the Measure Z Vehicle Replacement Account No. 3115009-450057.
