RIVERSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE AMENDMENTS RELATING TO ANIMAL KEEPING AND RETAIL SALE REGULATIONS

Following discussion, motion was made by Member Gardner and seconded by Vice Chair Soubrious (1) to receive and ordered filed the report on existing Municipal Code regulations pertaining to the keeping of animals, specifically related to bees, dogs, cats, chickens, rabbits, and racing pigeons; (2) to bring back to the City Council Utility Services/Land Use/Energy Development Committee separate discussions to address (a) kennels and catteries and license requirements for local breeders; and (b) regulations on the keeping of bees, chickens, rabbits, and racing pigeons; and (3) requesting staff set up a series of workshops to review and further discuss regulations for the keeping and sale of animals and seek input from the public.
