BACKGROUND

- 1. On January 17, 2023, the City Council adopted a Flag Policy, which established guidelines for commemorative flags.
 - 1. In January of each year, Council will consider the display of commemorative flags for the upcoming year.
 - 2. In addition to annual consideration, a Councilmember may at any time during the year, suggest the display of additional flags meeting the criteria of the Policy.

BACKGROUND

- 1. On June 6, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution 23996 authorizing the display of commemorative flags:
 - 1. Holocaust Remembrance Day (January 27 only)
 - 2. Black History Month (February, entire month)
 - 3. Women's Suffrage Victory Flag (March, entire month)
 - 4. LGBTQ Pride Month (June, entire month except for June 19)
 - 5. Juneteenth (June 19 only)

BACKGROUND

- 1. On January 16, 2024, the City Council discussed the commemorative flag schedule for the upcoming year (**two-step process**):
 - 1. Step 1: Approved the following flag schedule: Holocaust Remembrance Day, Black History Month, Women's Suffrage Victory Flag, LGBTQ Pride Month, and Juneteenth.
 - 2. Step 2: Directed staff to return with a resolution, which is on the City Council consent agenda for **February 27, 2024.**

COMMEMORATIVE FLAG REQUEST

- On January 23, 2024, Ward 4 Councilmember Conder requested an agenda item to bring forward a commemorative flag for **Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month.**
- 2. Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month (March) seeks to raise awareness about the inclusion of people with developmental disabilities in all facets of community life.

COMMEMORATIVE FLAG REQUEST

- 1. While there is no established commemorative flag for Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month, there is a commemorative flag for disabilities of all types, including cognitive and intellectual disabilities.
- 2. **Disability Pride Month** recognizes disabilities of <u>all</u> types: physical, cognitive and intellectual, psychiatric, sensory, invisible and/or undiagnosed.

Month of July The colors symbolize: 1. Red: physical disabilities 2. Gold: cognitive and intellectual disabilities 3. White: non-visible and undiagnosed disabilities 4. Blue: psychiatric disabilities 5. Green: sensory disabilities 6. Black: Mourns disabled persons who have died due to negligence, suicide, illness 7
